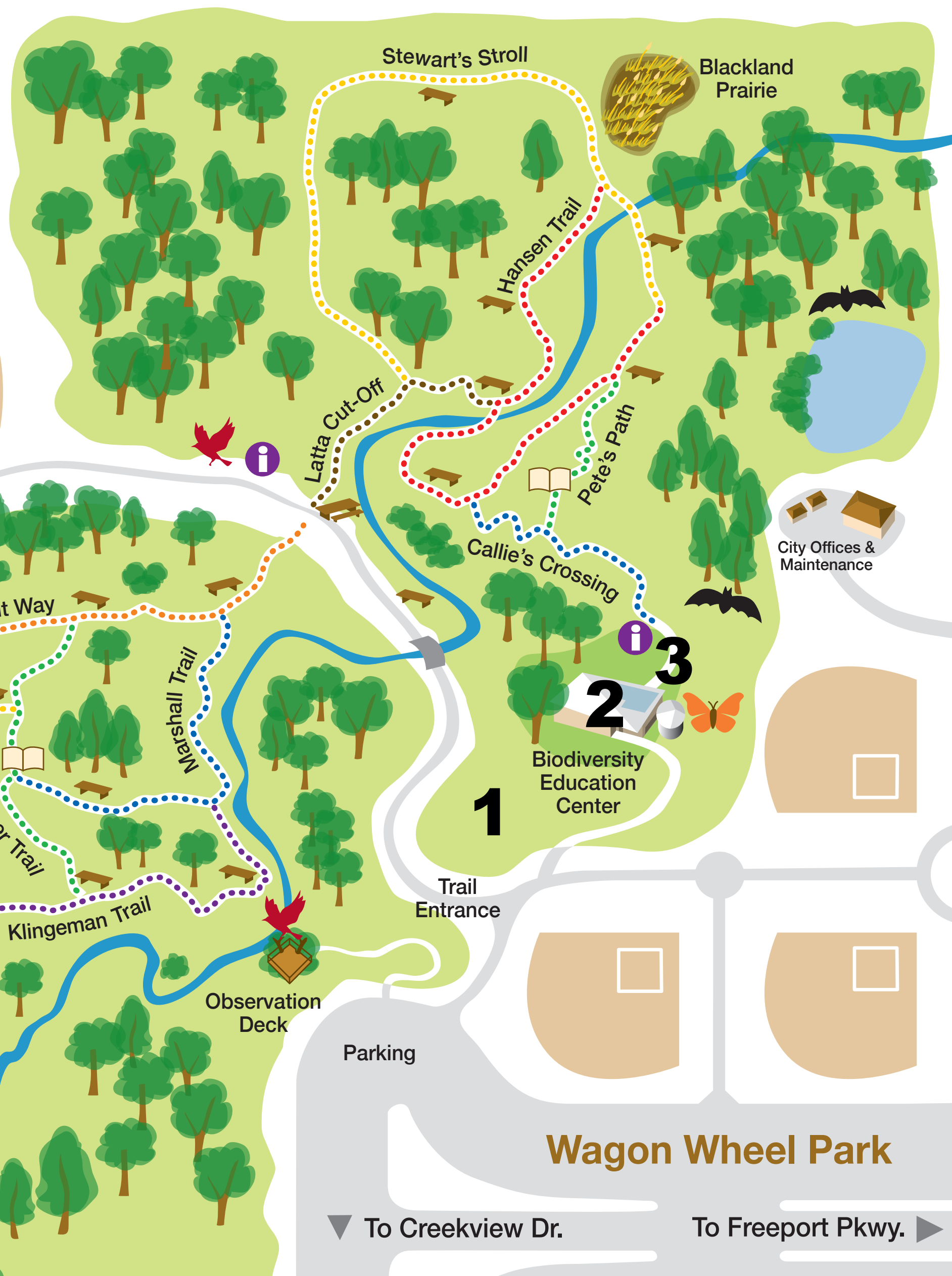


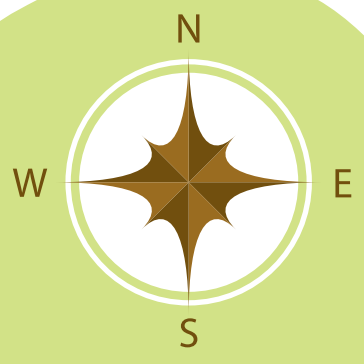
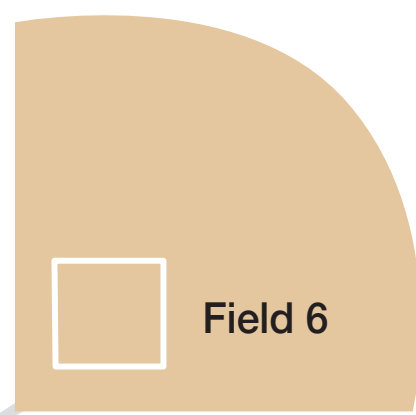

Where Cross Timbers meet the Blackland Prairie



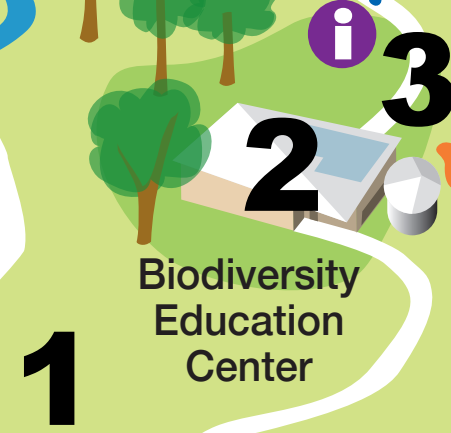
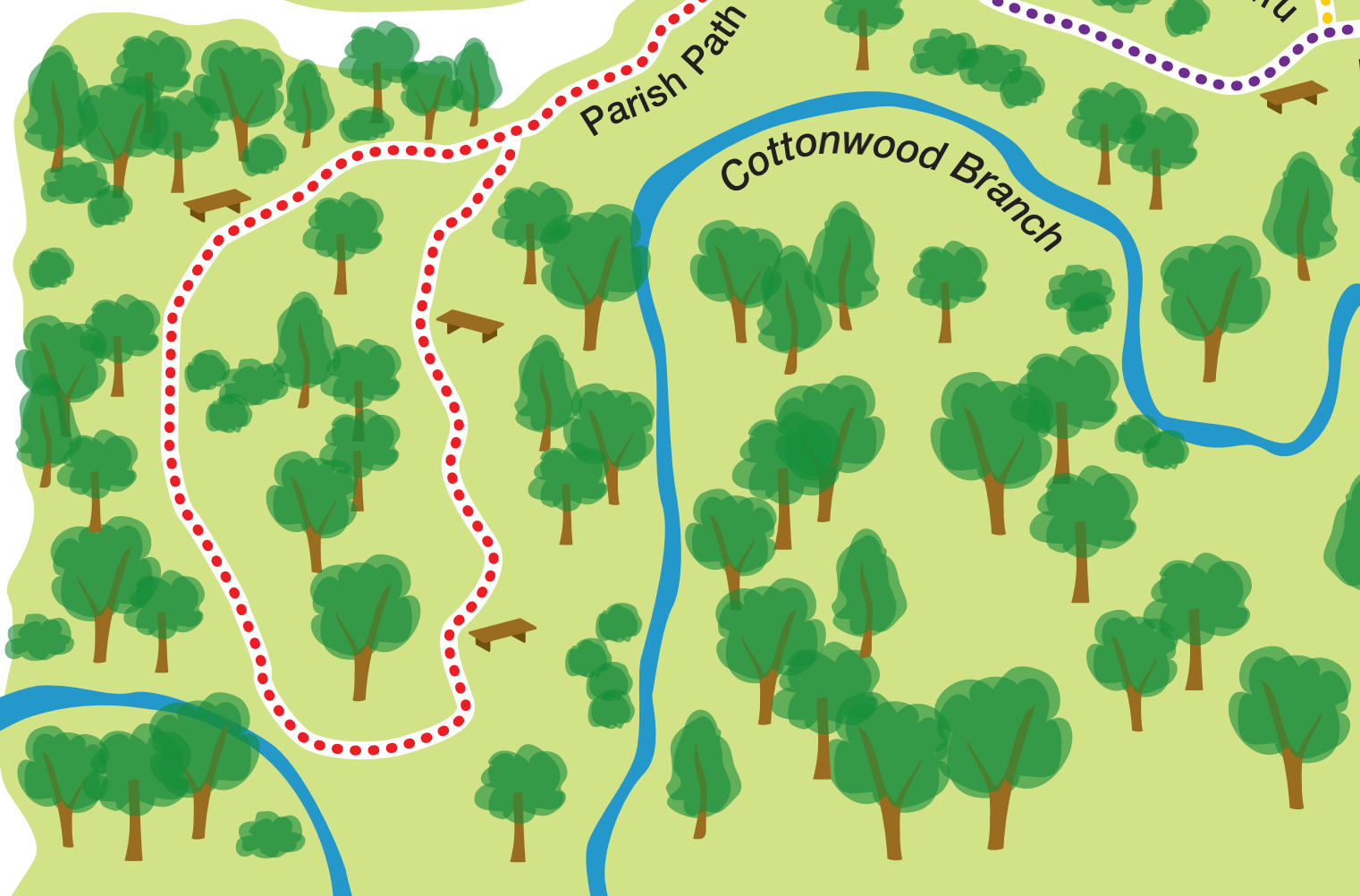
